

# ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION NOTICE

## Application for a Permit Amendment under The Provisions of the Environmental Management Act

Teck Coal Limited's Elkview Operations (RR. #1, Highway #3, Sparwood, B.C., Canada, V0B 2G1), intend to submit this amendment application to the Director, to amend Permit PE-425 (396838), issued August 5, 1971, and last amended on June 30, 2021, which authorizes the discharge of effluent from Elkview Operations.

The land upon which the Elkview Administration and Maintenance Complex, is situated, and the discharge occurs is Lot 1, District Lot 4588, and Kootenay District Plan 9330 located near Sparwood, B.C., within the East Kootenay Region.

The amendment requests to incorporate new effluent discharge locations and monitoring stations for Elkview's Administration and Maintenance Complex. It encompasses the construction of and discharges from a new sewage treatment facility, heavy-duty truck and light duty wash locations, maintenance shop and service bay oil water separators within the AMC.

Any person who may be adversely affected by the proposed amendment and wishes to provide relevant information may, within 30 days after the last date of posting, publishing, service or display, send written comments to the applicant, with a copy to the SE Coal Director, by way of Ben Barton, Environmental Protection Officer at the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy, 2080 Labieux Road, Nanaimo, B.C., V9T 6J9 or via e-mail at Ben.Barton@gov.bc.ca.
