Community Investments and Engagement Activities	Zoë provided an overview of local community investments supported by Teck's Legacy Properties Team since the last SLC meeting as well as a summary of community engagement activities that took place.
Site Activity Updates	Ryan Peterson (Sullivan Liaison Committee Co-Chair and Senior Supervisor Maintenance & Projects) provided an update on Sullivan's reclamation and Risk Management Plan, including updates on the ongoing regulatory inspections, environmental monitoring, and management programs.
Geotechnical Program	Teck confirmed geotechnical investigations on site are ongoing and there is good performance of all the tailings facilities.

Water Management	Ryan provided an overview of the water management plans and treatment process at Sullivan. Water is moved from underground workings, the lower mine yard area and Tailings facilities via seepage and groundwater collection to the Drainage water treatment plant. There is daily surveillance of these facilities and 24-hour monitoring. The treatment plant runs twice a year in the spring and fall.
Closure and Biodiversity	The site has been closed now for over 20 years. Teck is looking at innovative approaches for end land uses informed by community input.
Groundwater Remediation Plan	Ryan provided overview of the Notice of Migration of groundwater impacted by the Mine in December 2020 for Marysville and some townsite homes. Teck is working with the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy to designate it as an "Environmental Management Area" which assigns responsibility of the groundwater quality and its remediation to Teck. Input from the Ministry of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation and community is being sought.
Upcoming Meetings	The SLC will meet again fall 2023.
Questions and Discussion	Teck representatives responded questions from attendees, which included interest in underground tours, water treatment operations, water quality, baseline data for the site, Sunmine expansion, closure and reclamation research and development opportunities, water sampling, end land use ideas, and decommissioning of tailings facilities.
