



Teck Conservation Lands

As part of our sustainability efforts, Teck purchased approximately 7,150 hectares of private lands in the Elk Valley and Flathead River Valley for wildlife and habitat conservation purposes. The three blocks of land include Flathead Townsite (992 hectares), Alexander Creek (3,098 hectares) and Grave Prairie (3,059 hectares).

The Ktunaxa Nation and Teck have agreed to jointly manage the land for conservation purposes protecting significant fish and wildlife habitat. The Joint Management Agreement support the Ktunaxa Nation Stewardship Principles, and Teck’s goal to secure a net positive impact on biodiversity in the areas where it operates.
