- •drive continuous learning, improvement, and innovation in all aspects of health, safety and wellbeing and hold ourselves accountable through verification and reporting of our performance.
- •build a culture that recognizes and promotes health, safety and wellbeing among everyone who works at Teck and empowers people to speak up and participate.
