Notice: COVID-19 Protocols for Teck Corporate Office Visitors

Teck Resources Limited and its affiliates ("Teck") are focused on ensuring everyone goes home safe and healthy every day. To this end, effective November 15, 2021, all visitors, consultants, and contractors entering Teck's corporate offices are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Fully vaccinated means a person is at least 14 days post-receipt of the full series of vaccines against infection by COVID-19 approved by local public health authorities. Full vaccination includes prompt completion of any applicable COVID-19 boosters if an individual falls within the recommendations set out by public health authorities.

Before Your Arrival

Please review this document before visiting Teck's office. Ensure you have the following documentation with you for your visit:

- Proof of vaccination digital or paper form of your unique QR (Quick Reference) code or other
 official written documentation issued to you by local public health authorities that permits Teck to
 verify that you are fully vaccinated. If your unique QR code was issued by an out-of-province
 authority and does not contain sufficient information for Teck to visually confirm your vaccination
 status, then you will be asked to provide a different form of proof.
- Government issued photo ID the name on your photo ID must match the name on your proof
 of vaccination. Passports are accepted for international visitors.

24 Hours Before Visiting a Teck Office

All visitors to Teck offices must complete a <u>Mandatory Self-Declaration Form</u> and submit it to their Teck host 24 hours before visiting a Teck office.

Day of Visit to a Teck Office

All visitors to Teck offices must complete a <u>Take 5 to Limit the Spread screening</u> on the day of their visit and provide this form to Reception/Teck host upon arrival at Teck's offices. If the visitor answers yes to any of the Take 5 questions, they are not permitted to visit that day.

We encourage you to bring a three-layered surgical mask or KN95/N95 respirator that you are comfortable wearing as you are required to wear one when entering Teck's office building, in elevators, and in the hallways, washroom facilities and other shared spaces. Three-layered surgical masks and KN95/N95 respirator are available for visitors upon arrival at Teck's office.

Arriving at Teck's Office

Upon arrival, you will be asked to do the following:

Proof of vaccination check – You will be asked to provide your proof of vaccination and photo
ID. The name on your photo ID must match the name on your proof of vaccination. The check is
conducted by QR code scan and/or visual review of your documentation; we will not keep a copy
of your proof of vaccination or photo ID.

If you are unable to provide proof of vaccination that permits Teck to verify that you are fully vaccinated, you will not be permitted to continue your visit to Teck's office and you will need to make alternate arrangements.

During Your Visit

Everyone at Teck's office is required to wear either a three-layered surgical mask or KN95/N95 respirator when entering a Teck office building, in elevators and when in the hallways, washroom facilities and other shared spaces. People must also wear their surgical masks or KN95/N95 respirators in meeting rooms or other common areas if other individuals are present and physical distancing (less than two meters or six feet) cannot be maintained. Both surgical masks and KN95/N95 respirators will be made available to visitors. An interference free seal is recommended when wearing a KN95/N95 respirator to achieve the full safety benefit of the respirator.

Hand sanitizing stations are available throughout the office, including at reception and in meeting rooms.

Signage and floor markings are posted throughout the office to communicate Teck's COVID-19 safety protocols and promote physical distancing of greater than two meters or six feet. Please read and follow these protocols to help us promote a healthy and safe work environment.
