RESPONSIBLE SOURCING POLICY

Teck Advanced Materials is committed to upholding the principles outlined in Teck's *Charter of Corporate Responsibility*, *Code of Sustainable Conduct* and *Human Rights Policy*. This includes complying with all applicable laws and regulations; protecting the environment; ensuring the safety and health of people; and respecting the human rights of employees, workers in our supply chain and members of the communities where Teck operates. Furthermore, we expect our business supply-chain partners to share these commitments.

Teck Advanced Materials takes the following steps in assessing the source of any 3TG (tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold) minerals in our global supply chain. We use a reasonable, documented process to:

- Require that our direct suppliers' materials are DRC conflict-free.
- Verify that our suppliers source only from certified conflict-free smelters, such as those audited by the Conflict-Free Sourcing Initiative's [Conflict-Free Smelter Program](#).
- Expect our direct suppliers to conduct the necessary inquiry and, where appropriate, additional due diligence to provide us with confirmation of the source of the materials used in their processes and ultimately present in our products.
- Verify the smelter name from our supplier.

We also commit to institute the appropriate systems, procedures and practices to ensure the proper implementation of these objectives within our business activities.

Our actions on conflict minerals support our long-term commitment to responsible resource development and to respecting the human rights of all people.
