Teck Reports Fatality at Fording River Operations

Sparwood, B.C. – A fatal incident occurred at approximately 8:40 a.m. local time today, Monday, April 9, at Fording River Operations, resulting in the death of a contractor employee.

“We wish to extend our most sincere condolences to the employee’s family, friends and colleagues. We are all deeply saddened by this tragic incident and loss of life,” said Robin Sheremeta, Senior Vice President, Coal.

Appropriate authorities, including the RCMP and B.C. Ministry of Energy, Mines & Petroleum Resources, have been notified, and an investigation into the incident is now underway.

No other employees or contractors were injured, and there is no ongoing safety or environmental risk.

Fording River Operations is located approximately 65 kilometres north of Sparwood in southeastern British Columbia.
