Teck recognizes that access to water is a human right, and that water is essential to our business and to the communities where we operate. We are committed to protecting water and the life it sustains, and to being an industry leader in water stewardship.

In line with our member commitments with the International Council on Mining and Metals (ICMM), the Mining Association of Canada (MAC), and the International Network for Acid Prevention (INAP), we are committed to implementing industry-leading practices for the safe and sustainable use of water, including its reuse, management, treatment, and discharge.

As a company committed to water stewardship, we will:

- •manage water at our operations efficiently and effectively.
- •provide access to safe drinking water and sanitation facilities for all of our employees and contractors.
- •engage proactively and regularly with communities, stakeholders, and Indigenous Peoples in the watersheds where we operate to understand and collaborate on waterrelated priorities.

•integrate the cost and value of water into business decisions including those related to project development, business planning, and closure planning activities. •proactively assess and manage water risks and opportunities at our operations, and understand potential risks within our value chain.

•monitor our water performance, set targets, and report publicly on progress.

•build resilience to a changing climate and water-related impacts into our operations and logistics.

•drive continuous improvement and innovation in all aspects of water management.

•develop the water expertise of our people internally and externally, and proactively engage in water-related public policy and regulatory developments.
