

Zinc Saves Lives Battery Recycling Campaign: Terms & Conditions

- 1. Teck's Zinc Saves Lives Battery Recycling Campaign will take place beginning on September 28, 2017 and continue through to August 31, 2018, or until the campaign meets its cap, whichever is earliest.
- 2. Used household batteries will be collected at WE Day Toronto (September 28, 2017), WE Day Vancouver (October 18, 2017), and WE Day Alberta (November 1, 2017) and batteries will be collected at Call2Recycle collection depots across Canada throughout the campaign.
- 3. Call2Recycle will be responsible for sorting, processing and recycling the batteries collected throughout the campaign.
- Campaign participants who recycle batteries at Call2Recycle collection depots and wish to participate in Teck's Zinc Saves Lives Battery Recycling Campaign are required to report their name, the collection depot and the number of batteries recycled at www.zincsaveslives.com.
- 5. In September 2018, Teck will donate the cash equivalent to the value of zinc recycled from batteries at the price of CAD\$1.70 per pound of zinc, up to a maximum total of CAD\$10,000, to WE in support of zinc and health programs for children in Kenya. Teck reserves the right to limit the donations associated with a single name or collection depot.
- 6. Teck reserves the right to verify the reported weight of batteries recycled through any Call2Recycle collection depot and to make donations based on the verified weight rather than the reported weight.
- 7. Teck may suspend the Zinc Saves Lives Battery Recycling Campaign at any time at its sole discretion.
- 8. Teck will not use or distribute participant names at any point. This information is collected for the sole purpose of verifying reports of large volumes of recycled batteries throughout the campaign.
